



## Cambridge Brain and Behaviour Study

The CamBABS team is looking for men and women with classic CAH (either salt wasting or simple virilising) to help us with our research. We are conducting a study aimed at understanding how hormone exposure within the womb relates to brain structure and behaviour. You are eligible to participate in CamBABS if you are aged between 18 and 45 years and you have English as your first language.

### You will:

- Receive £30 for taking part
- Have your travel costs reimbursed
- Receive a picture of your brain!

### What will you be asked to do?

You will carry out tasks assessing a range of behavioural traits including spatial aptitude, throwing ability, personality characteristics, fine motor ability, and gender-related behaviour. We also will use a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scanner to obtain images of the structure of your brain and, if you are willing, obtain saliva and blood samples so that we can study your DNA.

### How long will it take?

You will be with us for around 3½ hours on a day and time of your choosing. The study takes place at Addenbrooke's Hospital in Cambridge on weekdays. If you are coming from further afield, we will reimburse you for accommodation and meals while in Cambridge, and can help you make your travel arrangements.
